#290 - The Pathway to the One World Order –

On May 22nd, President Trump was the first ever United States President ever visited the “Wailing wall” during presidency. Although he had been adamant about moving the US embassy from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem by regarding its capital as Jerusalem, the international community, including the US and Japan, has not been regarding Jerusalem as the capital of Israel.
